REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTICLES:

Work must be written using MS Office on a standard paper sheet A4 (210x297 mm) with standard structure (introduction, aim of work, materials and methods, results, conclusions, used tables or/and graphs list (if necessary) and literature links). Font – Times New Roman, size 14, line spacing -1.5, paragraph spacing – 1.25 mm, justified alignment, margins should be 20 mm at all sides.

The volume of abstract must be in average from 10 to 25 pages.

REGULATIONS OF THE REPORT:

Time assigned for each paper is:

- 10 minutes for oral report
 - 5 minutes for poster
 - 5 minutes for discussion after report
- Presentation must be saved as .ppt, .pptx or .pdf files. Presentations should not contain any videos.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS:

Papers must not be previously published or directed for publication in other editions.

Each participant can submit one paper or be a coauthor in two.

All abbreviations (except for commonly used measurements) can be used only after they were mentioned in full term previously.

Abstracts must not contain any graphs, pictures or tables. A paper must be no longer than 3000 signs (including spacebars), it should have structural type and should include: introduction, aim of work, materials and methods, results and conclusions.

Work must be written using MS Office on a standart paper sheet A4 (210x297 mm) with standart structure (introduction, aim of work, materials and methods, results and conclusions). Font – Times New Roman, size 14, line spacing -1.5, paragraph spacing – 1.25 mm, justified alignment, margins should be 20 mm at all sides. File must be saved as .doc or .docx and named with the name of first author (e.g. Smith.docx)
